O R D E R

THIS matter coming on to be heard upon the duly verified petition filed by Wilfred E. Hall, a reputable resident in said County that said children be found dependent and that a guardian may be appointed over said children by this Court, and it appearing to the Court that all persons interested herein, having had due notice of this proceeding, according to the Statute in such case made and provided; and John Ullian, the father of said children and said children being present in open Court by process of summons;

And this matter coming on further to be heard upon the testimony of witnesses sworn in open Court and the arguments of counsel and the Court being fully advised in the premises.

THE COURT THEREUPON FINDS, that it has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof, that the said children are of the following ages and sexes:

Mary Ullian,	female child	11 years	11/4/21
John Ullian,	male child	9 years	5/17/23
Livia Ullian,	female child	8 years	5/17/24
Jino Ullian,	male child	7 years	6/21/25
Joseph Ullian,	male child	4 years	12/24/28

and that said children are not now inmates of any State Institution incorporated under the laws of this State; and that said children are dependent children for the reason that the father as the sole living parent is unable to provide for them, nor are there any living relatives able to provide for them.

AND THE COURT FINDS that the father of said children, John Ullian, who is said to reside at 581 Laurel Avenue, Highland Park, Illinois, is unable to support and care for said children and has consented that a guardian be appointed over said

children by this Court.

THAT the mother of said children, named Linda Ullian, is deceased.

THAT it is for the best interest of the children and the People of the State of Illinois that said children be taken from the custody of the father, John Ullian, and placed in the custody of Illinois Soldiers and Sailors Children's School, at Normal, Illinois, and that the superintendent of such institution be appointed guardian over said children by this Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that said children, Mary Ullian, John Ullian, Livia Ullian, Jino Ullian and Joseph Ullian be placed by the father at 137 North Jackson Street, in the City of Waukegan, County of Lake and State of Illinois, and that the probation officer of this Court be and she is hereby appointed guardian of said children, to act as such guardian during the time said children remain at 137 North Jackson Street, Waukegan, Illinois, and said probation officer is to place said children in the Illinois Soldiers and Sailors Children's School, at Normal, Illinois, forthwith, until further order of Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the said children, Mary Ullian, John Ullian, Livia Ullian, Jino Ullian and Joseph Ullian be and they are hereby committed to the Illinois Soldiers and Sailors Children's School, at Normal, Illinois, subject to the rules and laws that may be enforced from time to time governing such institution and that Ralph Spafford, who is the superintendent over said institution be and he is hereby appointed guardian over the persons of said children, such appointment as guardian to take effect when said children are placed with him in said institution, and such guardian is ordered and directed to hold said children, care for, train and educate them until each of the boys have arrived at the age of twenty-one years, and each of the girls have reached the age of eighteen years, or until sooner discharged according to law;

And the Court hereby retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of making such further order herein,

for the welfare of said children as may be from time to time found in accordance with equity and in accordance with the Statute in such case made and provided.
